CALL FOR POSTERS AND FLASH TALKS

Greetings,

The New England Society of American Foresters will be holding its Annual Winter Meeting and Conference March 9-11, 2016 at the Sturbridge Host Hotel and Conference Center in Sturbridge, Massachusetts. The theme for the conference is "*Leadership and Innovation*".

For several years, a highly popular component of our meeting has been *The Flash Talks*. The session is structured for up to ten presentations, each no longer than ten minutes. Typically, the target presenter has been an undergraduate/graduate/younger professional who wishes to highlight a particular project/program with which they have been involved. Novel presentations (*i.e.*: case studies) from experienced individuals are also encouraged. This year, *The Flash Talks* will be held from 3:30PM-5:00PM on Thursday, March 10, 2016. Abstracts should be 500 words or less, and follow the format of the example listed below.

Individuals who may not be able to present their findings in person may be interested in presenting a *Research Poster* outlining their project or program. Poster guidelines allow for a space no larger than 48" x 48". (horizontal/vertical). Up to 25 posters can be accommodated at the conference, with an award certificate for the **Best Poster** during the Award Ceremony. Posters should be set up by 8AM Wednesday, March 09, 2016, and removed by 8AM on Friday, March 11, 2016.

Individuals interested in presenting at this conference should contact Joseph P. Barsky as soon as possible for more information or to ensure an opening. The submission deadline is February 05, 2016.
